On this 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1818—Before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of common Pleas in and for said County of Tompkins, personally appears Elias Larrabe, aged fifty two years old in June last, resident in the Town of Dryden in said County, who being my me first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress, entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and navel [naval] service of the United States in the revolutionary War.

That the said Larrable enlisted in Johnstown in the State of New York in the company commanded by Capt. Titus of the Infantry in Col. Wisenfelt's Regt, in the New York line of troops in the year 1780, he thinks for during the war, that he continued to serve in said Corps untill said Regt was deranged, and was then transferred into Capt. Walkers company in Col. VanCourtlandt Regt. That he has last said discharge. That he was in the Battles of Yorktown, in taking CornWallis.

And that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said services. (Signed) Elias Larrabe
