

## **Pension Application for Adam Trout**

On this first day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the county of Tioga and State of New York Personally appeared Adam Trout aged seventy nine years the third day of February last past Resident in the Town of Elmira in the County and State aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the Provision made by the late act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain Persons entitled "An act to provide for certain Persons engaged in the Land and Naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War."

That the said Adam Trout enlisted the service of the United States in the County of Orange and State aforesaid in the Company under the command of Captain Amos Hutchins belonging to Col. Richmore's Regiment in the York line on or about the first day of March in the year 1776, for the time of nine months which he served until the expiration thereof without any intermission, that then he enlisted again at the same place in the Company commanded by Capt Barret Ten Eyck in the January following after his first term of service had expired in the Regiment commanded by Philip Courtland in Gen James Clinton's Brigade for the term of three years, part of which time he was in Gen. Poor's Brigade. That he continued to serve the said Corps or in the service of the united States when he was honorably discharged at West Point in the State of New York in writing by Major Nicholas Fish which said written discharge has since been lost and destroyed.

That he was in the Battle of White Plains in the State of New York and In the two principal battles at Monmouth which last mentioned Battle was while he was under General Poor—and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his Country for support and that he has no other evidence now in his Power of his said services.
