

**Pension Application for William Waddell or Waddell or Waddle**

W.25847 (Widow: Olive) Married June 22, 1806. He died June 19, 1840.

County of Onondaga SS.

On this twenty third day of July 1832 before me the subscriber a Justice of the Peace for the said Court personally appeared William Waddel who on his oath declares that he is the same person who formerly belonged to the company commanded by Captain Aaron Austin in the Regiment commanded by Colonel VanSchaick in the service of the United States; that his name was placed on the Pension Roll of the State of New York; that he received a certificate of that fact under the signature and seal of the Secretary of War which certificate on or about the seventh day of September 1820, at or near the Court house or Clerk's Office of the County of Tompkins at Ithaca in said State he lost, as it now appears, but supposed that it was taken with his inventory to the Clerk's office and has made many enquiries concerning it without finding it; and this deponent now verily believes the said certificate to be entirely lost; that at the time of the said loss, this deponent was attending Court to make his inventory under the act of 1820; and subsequently received from the Pension office Washington a letter stating that he was continued on the Pension Roll; this deponent further saith that from the substance of the said certificate which is contained in a copy of this deponent's declaration and inventory his said certificate was numbered 12,121 and dated June 22, 1819 and this deponent has from 1920 to the present time attested his semi-annual Pension Drafts by the said copy of the said Deponents declaration and inventory which was certified under Seal by the deputy Clerk of Tompkins County and which this deponent was informed was a correct course, and now having been advised to apply for a new certificate, has made this declaration.
