Form of a Declaration to be made by the Officers.

For the purpose of obtaining the benefits of an act, entitled "An act for the relief of certain surviving Officers and Soldiers of the Army of the Revolution," approved on the 15th of May, 1828, I, Marimus Willett of the City of New York, in the county of New York, in the State of New York, do hereby declare that I was an officer in the Continental Line of the Army of the Revolution, and served as such ^{to the time when the arrangement of the Army, provided by the Resolves of Congress of the 3d and 21st of October, 1780, was carried into effect} at which period I was a Lieutenant Colonel in the fifth regiment of the New York line.

And I also declare, that I afterwards received certificates (commonly called commutation certificates) for a sum equal to the amount of five years' full pay; which sum was offered by the resolve of Congress, of the 22d of March, 1783, instead of the half pay for life, to which I was entitled under the resolve of the 21st of October, 1780.

And I do further declare, that I have received of the United States as a pensioner since the 3d day of March, 1826, nothing

Before me, Everett A. Bancroft, a Commissioner in the City of New York, in the county of New York and within the State of New York, personally appeared, this day, Marimus Willett and Everett A. Bancroft, of the said county, who did severally make oath that Marimus Willett, by whom the foregoing declaration was subscribed, is generally reputed and believed to have been an officer in the Army of the Revolution, in manner as therein stated.
